BULZ-I-BUCKET TOSS



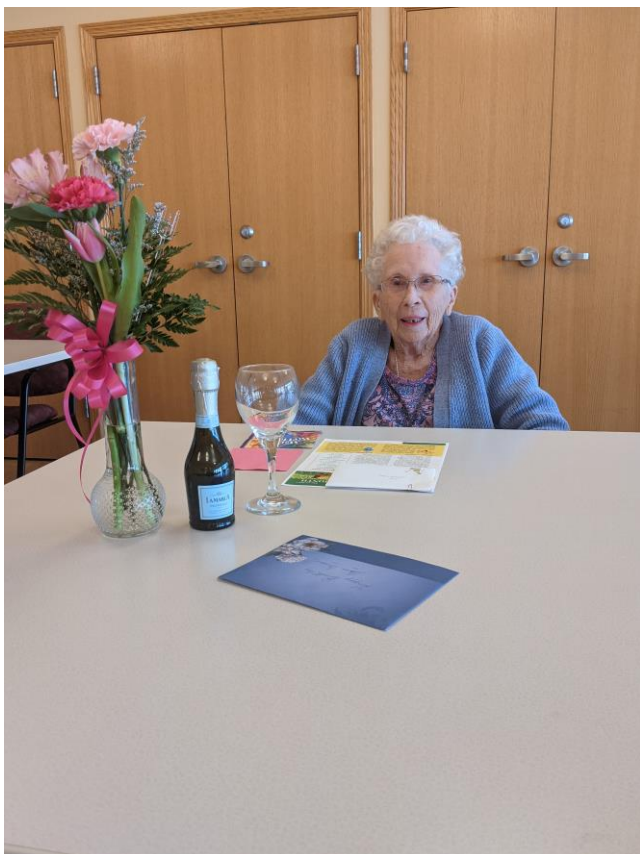
Harlan was the big winner of our new game called BULZ-I BUCKET toss. It looks easier than it is but all the residents caught on quickly and were piling on the points.
